1. Have you had contact with anyone that you know has been diagnosed with COVID-19? "Contact" is defined as being within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes with a person, or having direct contact with infectious fluids from a person with confirmed COVID-19, i.e., coughed or sneezed on.
2. Have you or has anyone in your household had a COVID-19 test in the past two weeks? What was the date of the test? What were the results?
3. In the past two weeks, have you or anyone in your household had symptoms of COVID-19 (fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, recent onset of loss of taste or smell, sore throat)? Please describe.
4. Have you traveled outside of the community within the last two weeks? Where did you go? Who did you travel with? Where did you stay? How long were you gone? Please describe in detail, using dates and locations.

5. Describe the circumstances under which you wear a mask, both inside and outside.

6. Describe how you practice social distancing, and when you started.

7. Who do you consider members of your “bubble?” People in a bubble stay in each other’s homes and do not socially distance. They count as one household and once in one, cannot start and switch into a different household. These are people with whom you ride in a car, share food, etc. The term “household” shall mean the same thing as bubble for the purposes of this survey and in any related paperwork.

8. Are there people in your household who work or travel outside of the community? Please explain with details.

9. Does everyone in your household wear a mask when outside the home? If not, under what circumstances are they mask wearers?

10. Do you have other comments or questions related to our concerns with COVID-19 exposure?
